Regular Meeting
January 8, 2026

Mayor A. Witt called the meeting to order at 6:36 PM. J. Farley made a motion to approve minutes from the November 6, 2025 Public Hearing and December 15, 2025 Special Meeting. M. Clement seconded the motion. All voted in favor. Motion carried. W. Hofferber made a motion to approve minutes from the December 4, 2025 Regular Meeting. M. Clement seconded the motion. All voted in favor with J. Farley abstaining. Motion carried.

J. Farley made a motion to approve the purchase orders. Clement seconded the motion. All voted in favor. Motion carried. The treasurer's and budget reports were reviewed.

S. Ogden reported 11 new accounts, 8 finalized accounts. Utility bills were printed for a total of 936 with 128 late utility bills printed. One account was disconnected for non-pay. The ACH total customers is up to 427 now. Thirty-three work orders were created, 1 building permit was submitted, and 59 purchase orders were made out. There was a total of 12 rentals for the Community Center for 2025.

W. Roybal reported 5,725,000 well water total gallons pumped with 754 lbs of chlorine pumped. Water testing all came back good. Four water meters were changed out. Well replacement for Well #6 will go through testing before it can be put back online. For the gas department there were 4 odor calls, 4 gas meters changed, 1 new gas meter was installed, EFV for the laundromat was removed. Totals for sewer gallons were 2,312,509 pumped into lagoons and 1,551,500 pumped from irrigation sprinkler. Yearly (2025) totals are 83,438,000 gallons of water pumped from wells, 35,616,781 gallons of sewer pumped into lagoons, and 8,755,900 gallons of sewer land applied. From June – December, 668.25 tons of garbage was dumped for a cost of \$24,548.32. There were 151 customers and \$3,072 revenue for the Landfill for June – December.

S. Hedrick reported 11 total citations for December. He said there is a class Guerrero Garcia and K9 Echo is going to for Commercial Trucks. The JAG Grant for \$7,646.00 was approved in full for the new radars.

K. Roybal reported the floor outlets in the library need to be replaced. The computers have gotten replaced, but the Microsoft account is in Carolyn's name.

Mayor A. Witt gave Robbie Wayman's update of the new fire truck is being built and that the Ambulance department is waiting on a power cord.

J. Farley made a motion to take no action regarding City Council member emails. W. Hofferber seconded the motion. All voted in favor. Motion carried. J. Farley made a motion to accept the Hooker Cemetery Maintenance bid from Panhandle Lawn Service, LLC in the amount of \$18,260.00 for 2025. M. Clement seconded the motion. All voted in favor. Motion carried.

There were no public comments. Under new business, M. Clement brought up something she heard and would like the City insurance looked into. J. Farley made a motion to go into Executive Session pursuant to 25 O.S. §307(B)(1) to discuss the employment, hiring, firing, appointment, promotion, demotion, disciplining, or resignation of any individual salaried public officer or employee. M. Clement seconded the motion. All voted in favor. Motion carried. J. Farley made a motion to reconvene the regular meeting at the conclusion of the executive session. W. Hofferber seconded the motion. All voted in favor. Motion carried. W. Hofferber made a motion to accept Anjanette Gibler's resignation. J. Farley seconded the motion. All voted in favor. Motion carried.

Mayor A. Witt said thanks for the holiday party and to Yuridia for coming to the meeting. W. Hofferber made a motion to adjourn the meeting. M. Clement seconded the motion. All voted in favor.
