Mayor Witt called the meeting to order. Farley made a motion to approve the minutes from the previous meetings. Schmidt seconded the motion. All voted in favor. Motion carried.

Hofferber made a motion to approve the purchase orders through consent agenda. Clement seconded the motion. All voted in favor. Motion carried. Treasurer Report and Budget Reports were also reviewed. There was no Public Comments.

Winter Roybal reported new material has been put in the alley at the 100 block between Oklahoma and California. It's \$500 per load and most alleys will require 3-4 loads per block. Total work orders made for the month was 138 and 86 were completed.

Carina Roybal told the Council Summer reading is halfway through. New flooring will be installed in the Library starting the first week of August on the main floor. The statistics for FY2025 is 3,004 items checked out, 1,985 items added, 11,963 items deleted, 38 patrons added, and 1,263 patrons deleted. She also talked about a bookshelf to be picked up from Alva and the Amazon wish list.

Three building permits have been turned in with two approved. Hedrick reported 38 citations issued for June. Wayman said he went to inspect the new ambulance last week. It will be delivered soon then will have to go to Oklahoma City for inspection before going in service. The Fire Dept is almost complete.

Ogden reported the Golf Course equipment listed on Purple Wave went for a total of \$1225.00. The Police Ford Explorer and 2 hustler mowers will be listed soon for the next auction.

Schmidt made a motion to approve to approve cleaning contract renewal for Misty Lynch Clement seconded the motion. All voted in favor. Motion carried.

Schmidt made a motion to approve base utilities of \$1007.28 for Hooker Chamber of Commerce. Farley seconded the motion. All voted in favor. Motion carried.

Hofferber made a motion to approve base utilities of \$1007.28 for Hooker Fights Hunger. Schmidt seconded the motion. All voted in favor. Motion carried.

Clement made a motion to approve base utilities of \$876.36 for Hooker Senior Citizens. Schmidt seconded the motion. All voted in favor. Motion carried.

In the Mayor's report, Witt talked Shelby Redcorn's new position and said that she might help be able to assist with grants.

Schmidt made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Clement seconded the motion. All voted in favor. Motion carried.
