Regular Meeting
October 5, 2023

Assistant Mayor Farley called the meeting to order. Farley asked for approval or corrections to the minutes of the previous meeting. Buschman made a motion to approve the minutes. Schmidt seconded the motion. All voted in favor. Motion carried.

Schmidt made a motion to approve the purchase orders by consent agenda. Hofferber seconded the motion. All voted in favor. Motion carried. Treasurer and Budget Reports were also reviewed.

Hedrick told the Council that the 2020 Charger of Wayman's had the fuel injectors and spark plugs replaced.

Roybal said Well #6 (NW Corner of Golf Course) had a camera ran down it and will be put out of service permanently. Bennett Construction will loop in the gas on Clara St from the alley between Broadway & Swem to the alley between Broadway & Ireland. The City Park and Homesteaders have had the trees and bushes cleaned up and hauled off including the area in front of the Swimming Pool. The benches and picnic tables have been painted as well as the pavilions. A roll off has been delivered by the trailer house at the landfill. The Maintenance department will start tearing it down as soon as possible. Potholes are being filled as time allows. Asphalt millings will be ordered to start spreading in the alleys for maintenance.

Lynch reported the Ambulance is sitting at a record number of runs for the year so far.

Schmidt made a motion to approve the renewal of mowing contract for the parks by Todd Kerr. Buschman seconded the motion. All voted in favor. Motion carried. Buschman made a motion to approve the renewal of mowing contract for the golf course by Todd Kerr.

Schmidt made a motion to approve the quote for new playground equipment and installation from ProPlaygrounds after some discussion. Hofferber seconded the motion. All voted in favor. Motion carried.

Hofferber made a motion to accept 2023 REAP Grant #TX23-4 Fire Hydrant Project as complete. Nine (9) Fire Hydrants have been replaced this year with the help of the REAP Grant. Buschman seconded the motion. All voted in favor. Motion carried. Hofferber made a motion to approve the 2024 REAP Grant resolution for Ambulance Equipment. Schmidt seconded. All voted in favor. Motion carried.

Buschman made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Schmidt seconded the motion. All voted in favor. Motion carried.
