June 4, 2026

Mayor A. Witt called the meeting to order at 6:34 PM. W. Hofferber made a motion to approve minutes from the previous meeting(s). J. Farley seconded the motion. All voted in favor. Motion carried. J. Farley made a motion to approve the purchase orders. W. Hofferber seconded the motion. All voted in favor. Motion carried. Reports were reviewed including treasurer, budget, revenue, and expenses.

Department Head reports were reviewed. W. Hofferber asked about spraying around the curbing to help control weeds and grass. W. Roybal said he would check what was available at the maintenance shop. J. Farley asked for clarification on sewer cleaning. Mayor Witt requested clarification from G. Garcia regarding the K-9 statistics report. S. Hedrick gave kudos to G. Garcia and K-9 Echo for locating a juvenile outside of Hardesty. G. Garcia also informed Council about taking K-9 Echo to Tyrone for checks before their Senior Trip. S. Hedrick reported having to get a headlight repaired on the car. R. Wayman stated the new fire truck should be delivered soon and that paperwork for the new fire building had been resubmitted.

S. Ochoa spoke with Council regarding moving water and sewer lines at the property located at 601 E Highway 54. Due to issues involving Ekkel's, he was unable to repair the lines and requested a zoning variance to run the water and sewer lines through the City easement on Chicago Street. W. Roybal discussed the process with S. Ochoa, including the requirement that a certified plumber connect the lines to the meter and that the property owner would be responsible for costs associated with moving the City meter and lines. J. Farley made a motion to approve the requested zoning variance. W. Hofferber seconded the motion. All voted in favor. Motion carried.

J. Farley made a motion to approve the Treasurer Bond for Misty Lynch. W. Hofferber seconded the motion. All voted in favor. Motion carried.

There were no public comments. Mayor Witt announced that the OHCE group would host activities at the park for the 4th of July and stated he did not expect the burn ban to be lifted by then. Everyone was invited to "Drag Main" on July 3rd. J. Farley noted that Kevin Stitt had signed legislation allowing fireworks to be sold year-round.

W. Hofferber made a motion to adjourn the meeting. J. Farley seconded the motion. All voted in favor. Motion carried.
